The Sanctuary candle is given on the one year anniversary of the repose of *Fr. Michael Trigg*...may his memory be eternal.

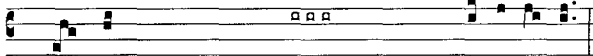

### THE LESSON: *St. James i. 22-27.*

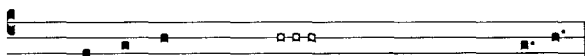

### THE HOLY GOSPEL: *St. John xvi. 23-30.*

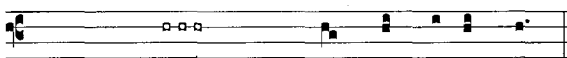
